Healthy Pipes Today and for Generations to Come

In 2019, the Oro Loma Board and staff embarked on a mission to replace 40 miles of pipeline by 2029. Why? Fewer pipes in need of repair means a healthier sewer infrastructure for our community now and in the future.

Old clay pipes are replaced with high-density polyethylene (HDPE) pipes, which are more reliable, require less maintenance, and are impervious to tree roots and rainwater entering the system.

Over the past five years, the District completed 11 projects, replacing 25.8 miles of sewer line. Some 14.2 miles remain to reach our 40-mile goal. At the current pace, we expect to complete the 40 miles of sewer pipeline before 2029.

SB 1383 requires **EVERYONE** to sort and properly dispose of their discarded materials. It also requires jurisdictions to monitor and enforce it.

SB 54 requires producers to make their packaging recyclable or compostable by 2032.
